Chili Cook-Off Official Rules

Saturday, October 21, 2017

The following rules are to be followed by all participants and/or their assistants for the cook off.

- You must cook a Chili. You can choose the type of ingredient you use in your dish. All dishes must be cooked on site on the day of the Cook Off from SCRATCH. Your meal cannot arrive pre-cooked.
- Contestants must supply their own ingredients or secure a sponsor to pay for the ingredients. The contestants will also supply all of their own cooking and serving utensils. The festival committee will provide bowls, forks, spoons and napkins, to be used for consumption by our guests who purchase Cook Off tickets.
- All ingredients in the main dish must be provided by the contestant, at his/her expense.
- Each Contestant must cook a recipe that will produce at least 40 servings. You will serve your dish into 6 oz. taster cups (which are provided by the Festival). Your dish is considered a donation to the St. Peter School Fishermen's Festival. Any leftovers after serving is complete will be brought to our cafeteria area for additional sale.
- Contestants will be permitted to set up their equipment, decorations, and other facilities any time after 12:00 noon on Saturday, October 21, 2017. You must supply your own table, chairs and other necessary equipment for cooking your dish. (Note: You are responsible for cleaning up your assigned cooking area at the end of this event.) **Also, please no outside food or beverages allowed.**
- Each contestant will be assigned a contestant's number by the chief scorekeeper for the Festival Committee and be given containers in which their entry will be collected in time for the official judging. Each contestant should make certain that the number on the bottom of the container is the same as their contestant's number assigned to them.
- Judging will begin at approximately 5:00 p.m. Samples will be collected from contestants for Judging around 4:45 p.m.
- After Judging is complete, an announcement will be made of the winners and you will begin to start serving the public (estimated time approximately 6:00 p.m.) Contestants or their designees must serve their dish until 7:30 p.m. or until your pot is empty.

- Contestants may place a poster identifying each chef, their entry and their sponsor, if any, at their cooking booth.
- A booth decorating contest will also be held, so please feel free to have a fun theme and be as creative as you like. An award will be given to the best decorated booth.
- First and second place awards, and a People's Choice award will be given.
